

The mechanism for dealing with students from lower-middle income countries

Treatment of Palestinian Students:

- A 50% reduction of tuition fees and academic expenses is applied to Palestinian students who obtained their General Secondary Certificate (High school) **from within Palestine.**
- Full tuition fees and academic expenses are applied to Palestinian students who obtained their General Secondary Certificate **from outside Palestine or from Egypt.**

Treatment of Syrian Students:

Syrian students enrolled in study **up to the academic year 2011/2012** are evaluated individually regarding the applicable fee reduction.

From **2012/2013 until 2015/2016** (including those whose enrollment was postponed to the academic year 2016/2017), they are treated the same as Egyptian students regarding the payment of tuition fees and academic expenses until graduation.

Starting from the academic year **2016/2017**, the treatment of Syrian students enrolled in study is as follows:

Category 1:

Students holding a secondary school certificate obtained in Egypt are treated as Egyptian students regarding tuition fees, academic expenses, and minimum admission requirements for Egyptian universities and institutes.

Category 2:

Students holding an equivalent secondary school certificate from Syria pay **50%** of the tuition fees and academic expenses applied to international students (and are subject to the minimum admission requirements for international students in Egyptian universities and institutes).

Category 3:

Students holding an equivalent secondary school certificate from **other Arab or foreign countries** pay **full tuition fees and academic expenses** applied to international students (and are subject to the minimum admission requirements for international students in Egyptian universities and institutes).

Treatment of Sudanese Students:

- Sudanese students pay **10%** of the tuition fees from the academic year **2002/2003 until 2023**.
- Sudanese students pay **30%** of the total registration fees and tuition fees starting from the academic year **2023/2024**.

This applies to **all international students enrolled in the first year**.

If a student is nominated for a scholarship in special programs or credit-hour systems, the student is required to pay the fees determined **in US dollars**, in accordance with the decision of the Supreme Council
