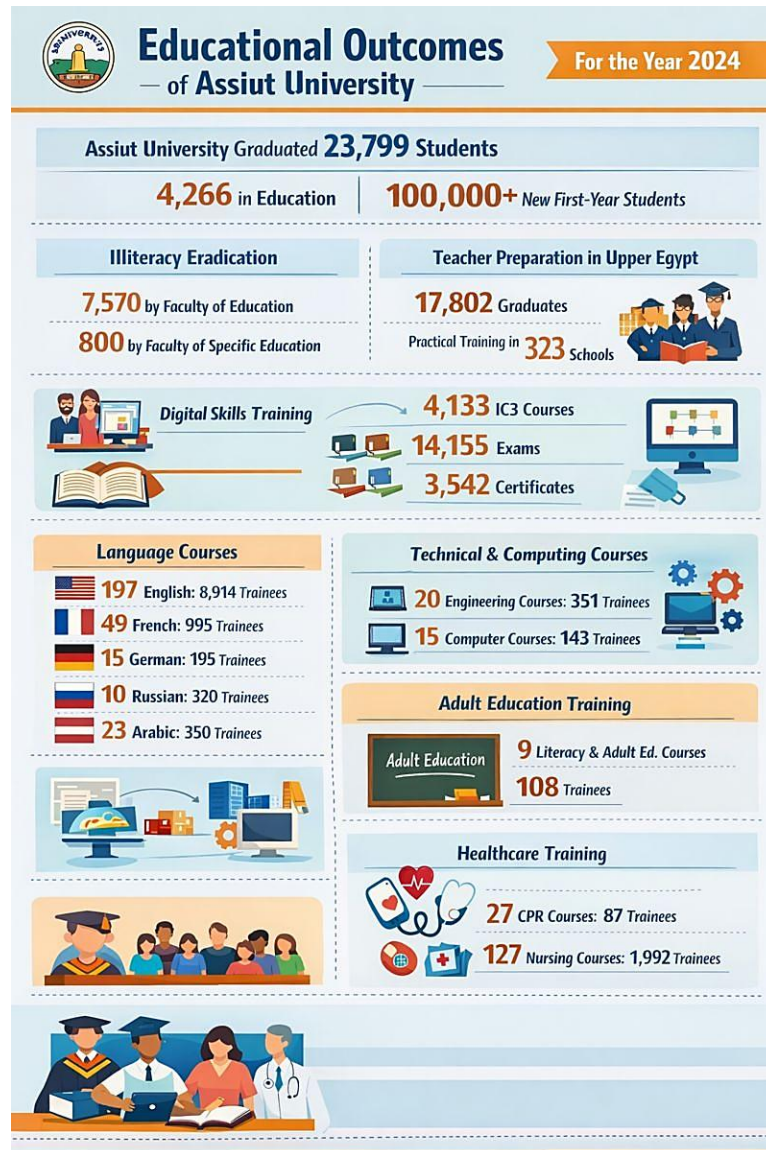

Educational outcomes of Assiut University for the year 2024

- Assiut University graduated 23,799 students in the year 2024/2025. This is including 4,266 in the field of education. Moreover, Assiut university did attract almost 100,000 first-year students in all university and faculties (In all under and postgraduate degrees).

- The university continued to play a crucial role for elimination of illiteracy and adult learning during 2024. Faculty of Education has eliminated illiteracy of 7,570, however; Faculty of Specific Education has eliminated illiteracy of 800 individuals from Assiut Governorate during this year.
- Assiut university is the main source for preparing future teachers in Upper Egypt. Collectively Faculty of Education, Faculty of Specific Education, Faculty of Early Childhood, and Faculty of Physical Education graduated 17,802 of our future teachers this year. Practical training had been performed in 323 preliminary schools in our Governorate. This training session was attended by 9,532 school students and supervised by 402 faculty staff members from pertained colleges. Moreover, The university also held a series of educational training activities for university students, graduates, faculty members, and visitors, including individuals with disabilities.
- With regard training for the International License Certificate, the university, through its various centers, held courses for The ICDL and the Digital Transformation Program (IC3) (4133 trainees in 83 courses). The university held 14155 exams to obtain the accredited certificates for these courses, and the university granted 3542 certificates. Similarly, university

centers established a 84 course in statistics (SPSS statistical analysis) for 1118 trainees.

- In 2024 our university held 197 English course for 8914 attendees. On the other hand, French Center performed 49 courses for 995 trainees. German Language Center also held 15 training courses for 195 trainees. Russian Center organized 10 training courses on different levels of Russian language with a total number of 320 trainees. Finally, the Arabic Language Center held 23 training courses on the different language skills for 350 trainees.
- The Engineering Education Development Center organized 20 courses for 351 trainees, including the following topics (AutoCAD, Civil3d K, Mos50, ic3, principles). Moreover, The Computer Consulting Center at the Faculty of Computers and Information held 15 course on apparitor, c plus, scratch, ic3 for 143 trainees.
- The Adult Education Center at the College of Education also organized a series of courses, the number of which was (9) On how to eradicate illiteracy and teach adults, methods and techniques for rehabilitating adults with learning difficulties, and employing technology in teaching adults and other topics for (108) trainees.
- The Respiratory Care Center at the Faculty of Medicine also held 27 basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation courses for 87 trainees. In the same regard, the Training and Continuing Education Center at the College of Nursing organized 127 courses on health services, analysis laboratories, effective communication skills, for 1992 trainees.



Educational Postgraduate courses in specialized centers (including people with disabilities): -

- The Desert Agriculture Center held 8 Courses on planning, installation and operation of irrigation systems for 180 trainees. The Dairy Products Unit organized 14 workshops on teaching dairy processing skills for 442 trainees.
- The university's Career Development Center held 23 courses during the year 2024. The topics Included employment skills, marketing and human resources, project management, occupational safety. Similarly, the

Institute of Biological Research held 19 training activity during the last year for 378 beneficiaries: including the following topics air pollution, infection control, the importance of health safety, promoting awareness against drugs, proper nutrition, DNA techniques and analysis, cell and tissue culture, scientific rules for preparing scientific research, and the foundations of plant tissue culture.

- The Psychological Counseling Center at the College of Education held a 43 Courses on teaching mathematics and science in English, effective teaching skills, and Arabic language courses for non-native speakers, with a total of 315 trainees. The Public Service Center at the College of Early Childhood implemented 35 courses on Montessori, communication at its various levels, the developed curriculum for early childhood, and other courses, with a total of 224 trainees.
- The Center for Legal Studies at the Faculty of Law also organized 32 courses with a total of 567 trainees, revolving around the preparation of the legal advisor, the preparation of lawyers and the practical aspects of legal drafting, drafting contracts in English, statements of claim and others.
- The Business Laboratory at the Faculty of Commerce held 76A course on IC3, MOS, programming, python for 752 trainees.
- The Measurement and Evaluation Center held several diverse courses, the number of which was 102 Courses for 2034 on electronic exams, scientific content analysis, preparing the specifications table, the foundations and methods of evaluation and its ethics, preparing the test item and other courses.
- The University's Center for University Education Development held a number of (53) Training courses, including the University Qualification and Accreditation course, the credit hours course, the e-learning course, systems management, and others, for a number of (6310) trainees.
- The Community Service and Environmental Development Training Center at the Faculty of Medicine organized a number of (39) A training course on first aid, technical assistance, and infection control for (552) trainees.

During this year the university as a body continued her program for carrier development and elevation the level of its university staff and assisting team through a few organized courses by specialized centers within its strategic plan to achieve its goals.

- The Adult Education Center at the College of Education organized 7 courses on strategies and skills for excellence and influence, problems facing leaders in adult education management, preparing certified trainers for adult education, designing an educational package for adult education for 105 trainees.
- The University Faculty Development Center has organized 237 training program on the ethics of scientific research, academic leadership programs, analytical and creative thinking, digital transformation, effective communication skills and other academic courses for 9041 trainees.
- The Technological Services Unit at the College of Education also held 11 courses. A course on research via the Knowledge Bank, conducting electronic tests, how to use the Microsoft Teams platform, and other topics for 193 trainees. The college also held a series of 7 teacher preparation courses for TAs, targeting 223 trainees.
- The University's Quality Assurance Unit also held 187 courses on analyzing course content, measuring the achievement of learning outcomes, course description, and other courses for 1113 university staff and TAs.

As for university staff They were trained by the Scientific Messages Service Center in the number of (15) A course on the linguistic formulation of scientific papers. These courses targeted employees of the Message Service Center in various colleges, numbering (240) employees. Similarly, the Central Libraries Administration held 42 workshops and training sessions on how to build a professional CV, communication basics and presentation skills, effective communication with people with disabilities, Arabic calligraphy for 342 trainees.

As for people with disabilities: The Center for the Care of Students with Disabilities held a series of training courses for university students and graduates with disabilities, and the number of these courses (43) for 857 trainees focusing on digital transformation for the blind, orientation and mobility programs for the blind, sign language, life development programs, English language programs at various levels, Photoshop programs, digital transformation and ICDL programs, graphic design programs, and other training.

As for educational conveys, the university organized 19 of technical educational conveys. included those on the benefits of food, macramé as a small business, recycling, wood carving, the basics of musical rhythm, clothing accessories, and the fundamentals of drawing for children, among others. These conveys benefited 673 individuals. The university also held 4 veterinary conveys covering animal treatment and vaccination, animal health and production, livestock, and rapid diagnosis of animal diseases, benefiting 303 individuals. Similarly, the university conducted 3 dental conveys to raise awareness about gum and teeth diseases, benefiting 75 trainees. Additionally 14 comprehensive medical conveys were organized, including caravans for examination and treatment, integrated health support conveys, medical checkups and tests, healthy living, and pharmaceutical awareness, benefiting 344 individuals.

The university also held a number of 91 workshop and conference during 2024 and educational seminars in various fields, including medical,

pharmaceutical, engineering, educational, psychological, artistic, agricultural, veterinary, literary, commercial and legal, with 2402 attendee.
