





In the last years, Egypt has suffered from many problems. One of them is Cancer. By spotting the light on the reproductive cancer, Egypt -as the rest of Cancers- suffer from increase in the incidence and prevalence of these cancers. Not only that, but also lack of research providing us with the essential data to fight these diseases. So, depending on the American cancer society Statistics we found that:

- 1 in every 8 women will have breast cancer in her life. (1)
- 1 in every 9 men will have prostatic cancer in his life. (2)
- 1 in every 250 men will have testicular cancer in his life. (3)
- 1 in 78 women will have ovarian cancer in her life and only 27% of women diagnosed in advanced stage will survive for 5 years because of lack of the awareness

Goal:

- Increase the awareness level in our society about breast cancer and testicular cancer
- It was through an Online campaign for more than 5 days, it reached more than 700 audience







World Aids Campaign WAC

This project serves the mission and vision of The Standing Committee on Reproductive and Sexual Health worldwide and in Egypt. It has been in the Spot light for a while and several LCs are taking it into consideration This project aims to work on raising awareness about decreasing level of stigma against HIV/AIDS patients in Egypt among medical students, and the public and Supporting the patients to be a productive part in the society which serves the Goals of IFMSA-Egypt as medical students' association working on the medical and awareness field.

-Aim:

- Our mission was to increase the awareness level about HIV and to relieve stigma related to this disease

Evidence Based Medicine project

Evidence-based practice is a systematic process primarily aimed at improving the care of patients and it aims at integrating individual clinical expertise with the best available external clinical evidence from systematic research and patient values to determine the appropriate treatment plan.

First aid for all project

First aid is applied to injured or ill persons in any health threatening settings in order to save life, prevent degradation of the situation or contribute to a treatment process before professional medical care is available. This refers to assessments and interventions that can be performed by a bystander (or by the victim) with minimal or no medical equipment.

Studies have found that the knowledge of first aid amongst medical students has always been a neglected subject. Hence, it should not be surprising to note that even junior doctors at certain hospitals cannot perform the first aid skills satisfactorily.

Our aim is increase students' knowledge on how to deal with emergencies as accidents, burns, and fractures

First Aid for all Mega workshop 4 phases have been done with more than 130 participants and with conjugation with Al Moseif initiative, with +300 participants.

A conjoint online campaign with KMSA-Kena, BMSA-Benisuef, MSSS-Minya, FMSA-Fayoum that will begin on 16/1/2021 and continue for one week









Towards better medical education project

Medical Education should be a concern of every medical student as it shapes not only the quality of future doctors, but also the quality of healthcare." In Egypt, medical education level has not been satisfying for decades. In this project, we propose ideas and plans to empower the Egyptian medical students; to be fully aware of their rights and duties in the education system. In addition, a plan to empower them to be an active participant in the education development process is proposed. A long list of partners is expected to help us with these plans, no doubt; as it's the duty of these bodies in the community.

- The passionate Scomedian Toka Ragab has been sent to national TBME TOT, and she gave her graduation session in E-learning.

Research team

Aim: As a research is a critical aim in national level and as ASSA-Assiut is one of the biggest associations in IFMSA-Egypt so it was a critical aim also in a local level so we did the following:

- Created a local Research core Team to Start the Broad Ranged Research initiative with the aim
 of reaching up to 50 students and revive the Mentor program which saw 75 students
 participating in 75.
- Made a conjoint with Medical Student Research Association to give an online research course to the participants and prepare them for the local and national research work.
- Giving the old research team national research team tasks to improve their skills

Projects: Together Against Stigma

According to UN statistics, the estimated number for blind patients in Egypt is 1 million, while 3 million are visually impaired and may progress to blindness. 80% are due to curable or preventable causes, 60% of which are cataract.

Statistics released by the United Nations also indicate that, in Egypt alone, 7.5 million people suffer from deafness or hearing impairment.

These patients suffer during their daily lives from being stigmatized and labeled as "disabled"; a mindset of "less than", rather than "differently-abled". They also suffer from institutionalized prejudice, unequal opportunities, and to a great extent, social exclusion.

- Our goal is to Improve quality of life of blind and visually impaired people and promote social integration.
- We aim increase awareness of medical and non-medical students about autistic people and promote social integration.
- Online campaign: we Posted about 6 posts in the online campaign and an awareness video about the Misconceptions about disabilities .
- Online Workshop: we have done an online workshop about stigma and disabilities and about 30 persons attended the workshop



Mental Health:

Mental health is defined as a state of well-being in which every individual realizes his or her own potential, can cope with the normal stresses of life, can work productively and fruitfully, and is able to make a contribution to her or his community. Over

Mentally ill people face many challenges starting with symptoms and disabilities that result from the disease, and all the way to stigma that result from misconceptions about mental illness. As a consequence, they find themselves robbed of opportunities like: good jobs, safe housing, satisfactory health care, and affiliation with a diverse group of people

- Our Goal is to Contribute to improve mental health status and decrease the prevalence of mental disorders in Egypt.
- This project aims to work on raising awareness about the nature of mental disorders, their causes and explaining that they are like any other disease so we shouldn't Stigmatize the person with mental disease in addition to stress and burnout and their management
- Online campaign: we posted eight posts in the online campaign.
- Online workshop: We made a cooperation with AAMSS Azhar Assuit





Blood donation

We did an amazing job with other NGOs "EPSF Assuit And operation smile" and conducted a very good physical campaign where we were able to get about 150 donations of blood.


